**VOLUNTEER PARENT DRIVER STATEMENT**

The Vancouver School District's policy and regulation regarding the private transportation of district students to and from school-sponsored activities states that the principal, or his/her designee, shall inquire into the following for the prospective volunteer parent driver:

1. They have a valid driver's license.
2. They can provide evidence of auto liability insurance on the vehicle (at least for Washington State minimums of \$25,000/\$50,000/\$10,000).
3. The automobile is safe and well-maintained, has a seat and functional seat belt for each passenger, and it is not capable of transporting more than 10 people, including the driver.
4. A State Abstract of Driving Record is available upon request.
